NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, January 10, 2017, a public hearing, as required by Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (the "Code"), will be held by the Fresno County Board of Supervisors with respect to the proposed issuance of revenue bonds (the "Bonds") by the California Municipal Finance Authority (the "Authority") for the benefit of Community Hospitals of Central California, Fresno Community Hospital and Medical Center and Sierra Hospital Foundation, each of which is a nonprofit public benefit corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of California and each of which is described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. Community Hospitals of Central California, Fresno Community Hospital and Medical Center and Sierra Hospital Foundation collectively operate as Community Medical Centers ("CMC").
