

RESOLUTION 20-114

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVIS, CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MARCH 2, 2021

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election is to be held in the City of Clovis, California, on March 2, 2021; and

WHEREAS, On December 10, 2007, Clovis City Council selected the Fresno County Elections Division to conduct subsequent elections beginning with the March 2009 Election; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Elections Division successfully conducted the 2009, 2017, and 2019 elections. The 2011, 2013, and 2015 elections were cancelled due to only one candidate for each office being nominated.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVIS, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Waive the bidding requirement, and authorize the use of the Fresno County Elections Division to conduct the March 2, 2021 election.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the provisions of § 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council requests the Board of Supervisors of Fresno County to permit the County Elections Division to conduct the March 2, 2021, City of Clovis General Municipal Election for the purpose of electing two (2) members of the City Council for a term of three years and eight months through November 2024 to comply with SB 415.


SECTION 3. In working with the Clovis City Clerk, the Fresno County Elections Division is authorized to perform any and all activities necessary pursuant to the conduct of the March 2, 2021, City of Clovis General Municipal Election.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to the provisions of § 10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, this City Council authorizes reimbursement to the County in full for the services performed and material acquired for the March 2, 2021, City of Clovis General Municipal Election upon presentation of a bill to the City after the election.
