PURPOSE FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021-2022) RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno is an eligible claimant of funds for Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds pursuant to California Public Utilities Code Section 142257; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Transportation Authority has adopted a Resolution of Apportionment for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds, setting the County of Fresno’s percentages at the following amounts:

- 26.21% of \$467,266 (\$122,455) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – ADA Compliance Category sub program;
- 31.06% of \$695,338 (\$215,796) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Bicycle Facilities sub program;
- 25.33% of \$13,327,988 (\$3,376,252) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Flexible Funding Category sub program;
- 70.28% of \$474,105 (\$333,192) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Pedestrian/Trails – Rural sub program;
- 6.14% of \$1,876,041 (\$115,113) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Pedestrian/Trails – Urban sub program;
- 26.21% of \$13,350,430 (\$3,498,707) for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Street Maintenance Category sub program;

which shall be the proportionate share of Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds that the County of Fresno shall be entitled to within the fiscal year.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 2 1) The County of Fresno hereby submits its Local Transportation Purposes
3 Certification and Claims for Fiscal Year 2021-2022 Measure C Extension
4 Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds;
- 5 2) The County of Fresno hereby requests the release of funds to the County
6 on a monthly payment basis consistent with the adopted percentages
7 listed above, based on actual receipts;
- 8 3) The Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno further certifies:
- 9 a) That Local Transportation Purpose Funds will not be used to
10 substitute for property tax funds which the County of Fresno had
11 previously used, or currently uses, to fund existing local
12 transportation programs; and
- 13 b) That the County of Fresno has, and will, segregate property tax
14 revenues used to support local transportation purposes so that
15 verification of non-substitution can be proved through audit and:
- 16 c) That the County of Fresno shall separately account for Local
17 Transportation Purposes Funds received, pursuant to Public
18 Utilities Code Section 142257. The County shall maintain records
19 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and
20 shall separately record expenditures for each type of eligible
21 purpose. The County shall make such records available to the
22 Fresno County Transportation Authority for inspection or audit at
23 any time.
- 4) The County of Fresno understands that should a financial or
compliance audit reveal that the County of Fresno violated any of the
requirements set forth herein, the Fresno County Transportation
Authority may seek to take immediate steps to resolve the violation in
accordance with its adopted procedures and applicable law.
