WHEREAS, the Local Health and Welfare Trust Fund 0135, 1991 Realign-Social Services Org 5246 will need to appropriate an additional \$37,063 to meet unanticipated expenses associated with the Aid to Adoptions Org 6415; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the FY 2024-25 adopted appropriations of the 1991 Realign-Social Services Org 5246; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the fund balance of the Local Health and Welfare Trust Fund 0135, 1991 Realign-Social Services, Org 5246 to fund the additional cost; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2024-25 1991 Realign-Social Services Org 5246 as follows:
