WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that a stop sign be installed at the intersection of Amber Avenue and Rorden Street, where Rorden Street intersects with Amber Avenue making it a one-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Amber Avenue and Rorden Street is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Amber Avenue and Rorden Street a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Amber Avenue and Rorden Street, stopping eastbound traffic on Rorden Street.

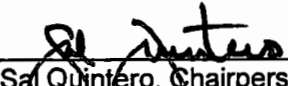

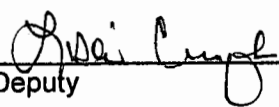
