PUBLICATION OF SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS COUNTY OF FRESNO

The Fresno County Board of Supervisors is giving notice that at their regularly scheduled meeting on January 9, 2024, at 9.30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, at the Fresno County Hall of Records, Board of Supervisors Chambers, 3rd Floor, 2281 Tulare Street, Fresno, California, they will consider adoption of the ordinance summarized below.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE

To amend Fresno County Ordinance code, Title 8, to add Chapter 8.52, "Fresno County Infectious Materials Ordinance, which will give the County authority to address the lack of federal regulation for laboratories that currently do not fall under federal regulations 42 United States Code (USC) § 263a and 42 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) § 493. Specifically, the Ordinance will provide authority for the County to conduct onsite visits of private property and evaluate if laboratories that are not regulated by Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments (CLIA) are in compliance with Hazardous Materials laws and general applicable clinical laboratory safety requirements. Although the Ordinance applies to laboratories located within the County's jurisdiction, incorporated cities can sign an MOU with the County that allows the County the authority to go onto private property within the incorporated cities to conduct this type of oversight and inspection.
