WITH EXTRA HELP RETIREE) GOVT. CODE SECTION 7522.56(f)(1)

WHEREAS, Executive Assistant, Marsha Koop, retired on September 30, 2024;
and

WHEREAS, the Public Defender will have a vacant Executive Assistant position;
and

WHEREAS, Marsha Koop has an extensive background with over twenty-five years of County
experience as an Executive Assistant. This experience has given her a unique understanding of the
Public Defenders Office and County procedures with extensive knowledge in complex personnel
submittals and administrative needs;

and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation
period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's
governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment, and that the appointment is necessary to
fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts
this Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Marsha Koop on an as-needed basis, effective February 3, 2025,
finding and certifying that the provisions of Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred
eighty (180) separation period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-help are not
applicable to Mrs. Koop, because of the nature of Mrs. Koop's employment and her appointment is
necessary to fill a critically-needed position before 180 days has passed following the date of Mrs. Koop's
retirement.


