## **AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO SERVICE AGREEMENT**

This Amendment No. 1 to Service Agreement ("Amendment No. 1") is dated <a href="December 9, 2025">December 9, 2025</a> and is between ReliaStar Life Insurance Company, a Minnesota Corporation, ("Contractor"), and the County of Fresno, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County").

## **Recitals**

- A. On December 17, 2024, the County and the Contractor entered into County agreement number 24-669 ("Agreement"), to provide optional Accident Insurance, Critical Illness Insurance, and Hospital Confinement Indemnity Insurance to its employees and their eligible family members.
- B. Contractor filed enhanced Accident Insurance, Critical Illness Insurance, and Hospital Confinement Indemnity Insurance benefits with the State of California, which were approved effective January 1, 2026.
- C. County wishes to replace the benefits currently provided by the Agreement, with the enhanced benefits offered by Contractor, for the benefit of County employees and their eligible family members.
- D. The County and the Contractor now desire to amend the Agreement to provide enhanced Accident Insurance, Critical Illness Insurance, and Hospital Confinement Indemnity Insurance to its employees and their eligible family members.

The parties therefore agree as follows:

- 1. Exhibit A of the Agreement is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the attached Exhibit A, effective January 1, 2026.
- 2. When both parties have signed this Amendment No. 1, the Agreement and this Amendment No. 1 together constitute the Agreement.
  - 3. The Contractor represents and warrants to the County that:
    - a. The Contractor is duly authorized and empowered to sign and perform its obligations under this Amendment No. 1.

- b. The individual signing this Amendment No. 1 on behalf of the Contractor is duly authorized to do so and his or her signature on this Amendment No. 1 legally binds the Contractor to the terms of this Amendment No. 1.
- 4. The parties agree that this Amendment No. 1 may be executed by electronic signature as provided in this section.
  - a. An "electronic signature" means any symbol or process intended by an individual signing this Amendment No. 1 to represent their signature, including but not limited to (1) a digital signature; (2) a faxed version of an original handwritten signature; or (3) an electronically scanned and transmitted (for example by PDF document) version of an original handwritten signature.
  - b. Each electronic signature affixed or attached to this Amendment No. 1 (1) is deemed equivalent to a valid original handwritten signature of the person signing this Amendment No. 1 for all purposes, including but not limited to evidentiary proof in any administrative or judicial proceeding, and (2) has the same force and effect as the valid original handwritten signature of that person.
  - c. The provisions of this section satisfy the requirements of Civil Code section 1633.5, subdivision (b), in the Uniform Electronic Transaction Act (Civil Code, Division 3, Part 2, Title 2.5, beginning with section 1633.1).
  - d. Each party using a digital signature represents that it has undertaken and satisfied the requirements of Government Code section 16.5, subdivision (a), paragraphs (1) through (5), and agrees that each other party may rely upon that representation.
  - e. This Amendment No. 1 is not conditioned upon the parties conducting the transactions under it by electronic means and either party may sign this Amendment No. 1 with an original handwritten signature.
- 5. This Amendment No. 1 may be signed in counterparts, each of which is an original, and all of which together constitute this Amendment No. 1.

6. The Agreement as amended by this Amendment No. 1 is ratified and continued. All provisions of the Agreement and not amended by this Amendment No. 1 remain in full force and effect.
