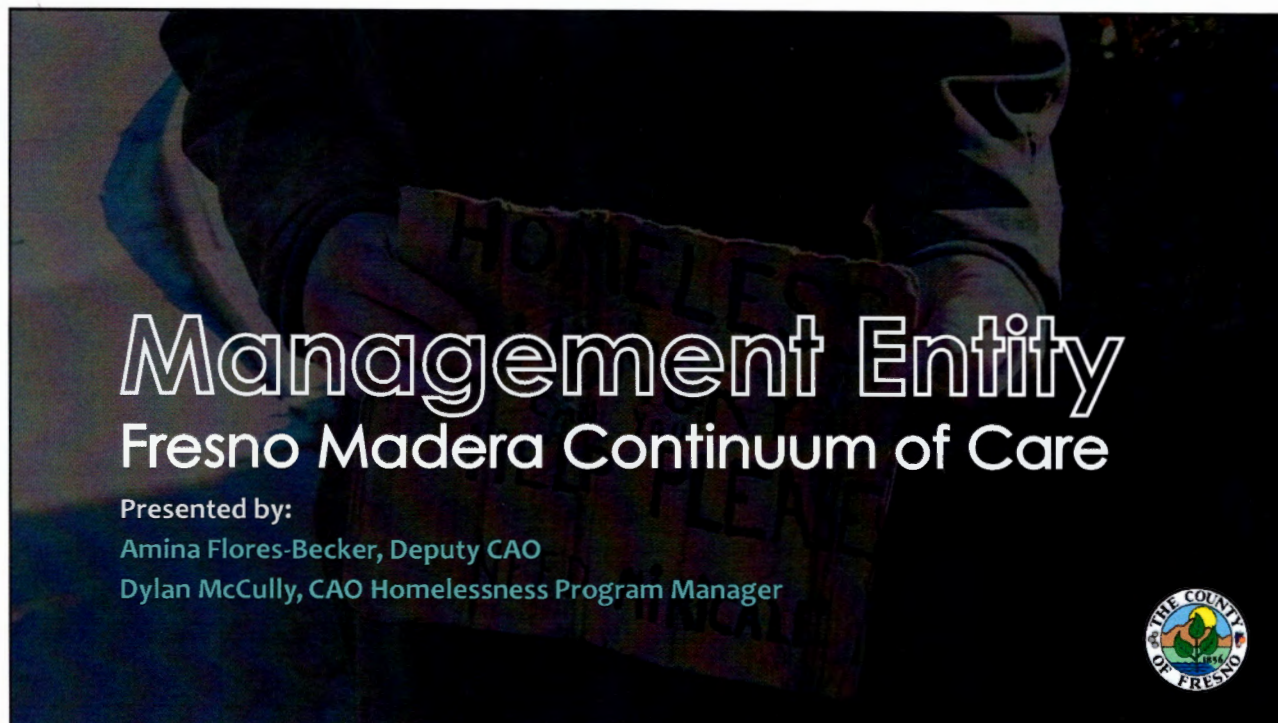

What is the Management Entity?

- ✓ Implements Coordinated Entry System (CES) policies set by the CES Committee and the FMCoC
- ✓ Oversight of CES projects to ensure system-wide CES coordination & Evaluation
- ✓ Coordinates outreach and navigation
- ✓ Training lead for all CES-related functions
- ✓ Management of Access Sites
- ✓ Coordinates with specific group service providers (ex: veterans, justice system, & tribes)
- ✓ Assessment, Match, and Prioritization
- ✓ Works integrally with CA and AE to develop and implement systemwide efficiencies

Who's doing it now?

- Currently contracted directly through HUD to a local non-profit partner (Poverello House).
- The recommendation to transfer the ME function to the County was made by the FMCoC non-conflicted committee.
- Staff's recommendation is to work with Poverello House through a transition period to determine logistically how the ME function will be assumed by the County.

Why do this?

- ✓ Strengthens accountability and oversight
- ✓ Alignment across systems of care
- ✓ Administrative consistency
- ✓ System-wide improved strategic planning and data integration
- ✓ Leveraging of County's homeless response system and existing partnerships

- Administrative Burden
 - High workload
 - Staffing and capacity
- Compliance & Liability Exposure
 - HUD compliance risk
- Financial Risks
 - Cash flow
 - Federal funding unknowns
- Public Accountability
 - Held to a higher standard

Create the **Management Entity function** within the CAO's office.



Work with the Poverello House to **transition the function** to the County.
