SENATE BILL 1 FLINDING FOR FY 2025-26	

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure that the residents of Fresno County are aware of the projects proposed for funding in the community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the County must adopt by resolution a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the County will receive an estimated \$29,276,170 in RMRA funding in FY 2025-26 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, this is the eighth year in which the County is receiving SB 1 funding, and such funding will enable the County to continue essential road maintenance and rehabilitation projects, safety improvements, repair and replacement of aging bridges, and will increase access and mobility options for the traveling public that would not have otherwise been possible without SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the County has conducted community outreach to allow for public input into our community's transportation priorities/the project list; and

WHEREAS, the County used a Pavement Management System and the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) biannual bridge inspection reports to develop the attached SB 1 Project List to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the

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community's priorities; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the County maintain and rehabilitate streets/roads, bridges, add active transportation infrastructure throughout the County this year and similar projects into the future; and

WHEREAS, the 2023 California Statewide Local Streets and Roads Needs Assessment found that the County's streets and roads are in "at-risk" condition, and this revenue will help us increase the overall quality of our road system and over the next decade will bring our streets and roads into a "good" condition; and

WHEREAS, the SB 1 project list and overall investment in our local streets and roads infrastructure with a focus on basic maintenance and safety, provide widened paved shoulders, and replace bridges which are structurally deficient, investing in complete streets infrastructure, and using cutting-edge technology, materials and practices, will have significant positive co-benefits statewide.

WHEREAS, the County desires to amend the list of projects to be funded by SB 1 previously submitted as Exhibit A to Resolution 25-177, in order to include additional projects in need of secured funding for Fiscal Year 2025-26.

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno, State of California, as follows:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct.
- The list of newly proposed projects that will be funded in Fiscal Year 2025-26, partially or entirely with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenue, is attached hereto as Exhibit A. This list further declares the projects intended to be performed by force account pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22031(g).
