Real property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction of the County if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the County (including its incorporated cities) or within two miles of any land owned or used by the County.
2. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity producing, distributing, or harvesting any produce subject to inspection by the Fresno County Department of Agriculture.
3. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity distributing, applying, or selling at retail any pesticide or agricultural product used for rodent and plant, pest or disease control.
4. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity utilizing, distributing, or repairing any measuring, weighing, or timing device required to be sealed by the Fresno County Department of Agriculture, or any business entity selling at wholesale or retail any petroleum or packaged product subject to inspection by the Fresno County Department of Agriculture.

Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted or in the future foreseeably may contract with Fresno County through its Public Works and Planning Department, Solid Waste Commissions within the jurisdiction, or to any other joint powers agency which Fresno County is a member to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment to the County.

Such written determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that determination, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Sheriff - Coroner's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.

EXHIBIT "B"

SHERIFF – CORONER

1. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments, interests in real property, sources of income (including gifts), and business positions. Financial interests (other than gifts) are reportable only if located within or subject to the jurisdiction of Fresno County, or if the business entity is doing business or planning to do business in the jurisdiction, or has done business within the jurisdiction at any time during the two years prior to the filing of the statement. Real property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction of the County if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the County (including its incorporated cities) or within two miles of any land owned or used by the County.
2. Persons in this category shall disclose all reportable investments in, income from (including gifts), and business positions with any business entity which, within the last two years, has contracted with or in the future foreseeably may contract with Fresno County to provide services, supplies, materials, machinery, or equipment to the Fresno County Sheriff - Coroner's Office.
