IN THE AMOUNT OF \$165,655)

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services - General Relief
Organization 6645 requires an increase of \$165,655 in appropriations in
order to make mandated assistance payments; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Social Services has recommended to
release FY 2014-15 net County cost from the Aid to Adoptions Organization
6415; and

WHEREAS, \$165,655 of the net County cost released will then be
available and recommended to cover these mandated General Relief
payments; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the FY 2014-15 adopted
appropriations for the Department of Social Services - General Relief
Organization 6645; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the
appropriations of these funds by a 4/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-
Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY
2014-15 budget of the Department of Social Services Dependent - General
Relief Organization 6645 as follows:
