WHEREAS, Alcohol Abuse Ed & Prev – SB920 expenditures are estimated at \$22,125; and
WHEREAS, the Behavioral Health Org 5630 requires an increase in appropriations and estimated
revenues in the amount of \$22,125; and
WHEREAS, Behavioral Health Org 5630 will receive funds as an Operating Transfer In from the
Alcohol Abuse Ed & Prev – SB920 ORG 1061; and
WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the adopted appropriations and estimated revenues
for FY 2024-25 Behavioral Health Org 5630; and
WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds
by a 4/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors;
NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is
authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2024-25 Behavioral Health Org 5630 as follows:


