RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Public Works – Special Studies Deposit Org 1186 had previously received special revenue funds from various developers for Environmental Impact Reports and General Plan Amendments projects in the amount of \$1,583,127; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works – Special Studies Deposit Org 1186 requires \$850,000 to meet expenditures associated with project work; and

WHEREAS, \$1,583,127 is available in the fund balance of the Special Revenue Fund 0085, the Public Works – Special Studies Deposit Org 1186 to fund these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in the adopted appropriations for the FY 2018-19 Public Works – Special Studies Deposit Org 1186; and

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2018-19 Public Works – Special Studies Deposit Org 1186 as follows:

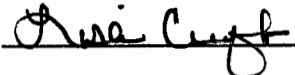
