
WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Annadale and Newmark Avenues, making it an all-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Annadale and Newmark Avenues is under the shared jurisdiction between the County of Fresno and the City of Sanger, with the west leg and west side of the north leg under City of Sanger jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Annadale and Newmark Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Annadale and Newmark Avenues, stopping eastbound and westbound traffic on Annadale Avenue.
