WHEREAS, local historic businesses, associations, and clubs that have persevered and flourished for over a century have greatly contributed to the story and history of our County; and


WHEREAS, the County has several archaeological sites, buildings and structures which have been listed on the National Register for Historic Places and state and local listings; and
