WHEREAS, Account Clerk, Helen Chu, will retire on December 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office will have a vacant Account Clerk position; and

WHEREAS, Account Clerks are critical to maintain operational mandates through account transactions mandated by the probate court and probate law; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the nature of employment and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) separation period has passed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Helen Chu on an as-needed basis effective December 15, 2020, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) separation period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-Help are not applicable to Helen Chu, because the nature of Helen Chu's employment and her appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before 180 days has passed following the date of Helen Chu's retirement.
