WHEREAS, the Active Transportation Program (ATP) provides grant funds for eligible local agencies for the purposes of increasing the proportion of biking and walking trips, increasing safety and mobility for non-motorized users, advancing the efforts of regional agencies to achieve greenhouse gas reduction goals, enhancing public health, and addressing childhood obesity; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Planning (Department) has applied to the 2023 ATP Cycle 6 for funding of ATP projects on June 15, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Department, and the Fresno County Board of Supervisors, wish to express: 1) its commitment to, and support of, the ATP and the projects the Department submitted in the related 2023 ATP Cycle 6 call for projects; 2) its approval of the underlying program of projects, as expressed in the ATP applications the Department submitted to the 2023 ATP Cycle 6; and 3) its dedication to delivering the projects as programmed and by the deadlines that will be later agreed upon between the Department and the Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG) and/or other governmental agencies, if and when the projects receive funding.

- 1) Its commitment to, and support of, the ATP and the projects the Department submitted in the related 2023 ATP Cycle 6 applications;

- 3) Its dedication to delivering the projects as programmed and by the deadlines that will be later
