10 **WHEREAS**, The County of Fresno and the Northern and Central California Affiliate of Susan G.
11 Komen® encourage County of Fresno employees and residents to participate in breast cancer awareness
12 activities this October and all year long; and

13 **WHEREAS**, The County of Fresno is observing Pink Day today, wearing pink with pride to bring
14 attention to the importance of early detection and breast cancer prevention. The County will be offering
15 on-site mammograms for employees the week of October 21st; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Four Steps to Breast Self-Awareness include knowing your risk, getting screened,
17 knowing what is normal for you, and making healthy lifestyle choices. Early detection and utilizing the
18 Four Steps are critical to early detection and treatment, and both of which can preserve lives; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Susan G. Komen® focuses on addressing insufficient access to care by focusing
20 on those with the fewest resources. They work to support uninsured, under-insured, and low-income
21 women and men unable to access care. Since 2017, Susan G. Komen® Northern and Central California
22 has educated nearly 7,500 women on breast health, and provided access to mammograms to nearly
23 3,000; and

24 **WHEREAS**, Susan G. Komen® Northern and Central California will sponsor the Susan G.
25 Komen More Than Pink Walk™ on October 12, 2019 at California State University, Fresno, where
26 thousands of residents will come out to support this worthy cause.

27 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby
28 proclaims October 2019 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month in Fresno County and calls upon all County
of Fresno employees and residents to encourage women to empower themselves with the Four Steps to
Breast Self-Awareness.
