PROCLAIM APRIL 18-25, 2026, AS TREE FRESNO'S 40TH ANNIVERSARY WEEK IN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO)

WHEREAS, Tree Fresno's 40th Anniversary Week Proclamation (April 18-25) is observed throughout the County of Fresno, celebrating the region's only urban tree planting organization, devoted to "expanding the urban tree canopy across the Central San Joaquin Valley through the planting of large-canopy, drought-tolerant trees"; and

WHEREAS, the work performed by Tree Fresno, resulting in the planting of over 55,000 new trees throughout the Central San Joaquin Valley, has been a partnership with cities, counties, educational institutes, businesses, non-profits, public agencies, homeowners, and more with significant help from community volunteers and contributors; and

WHEREAS, trees serve to clean air, produce oxygen, cut heating and cooling costs, moderate the temperature, produce shade, reduce the erosion of our topsoil by wind and water, and provide habitat for wildlife; and

WHEREAS, trees are renewable resources giving us paper, wood for our homes, fuel for our fires, and countless other wood products; and


WHEREAS, trees in our county increases property values, enhance the economic vitality of business areas, and beautify our community; and

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno recognizes Tree Fresno's 40 years of commitment to tree planting and education throughout the Central San Joaquin Valley.


