RESOLUTION NO. 25-075

6 **WHEREAS**, the non-profit Fresno Cycling Club will hold the 46th annual "Climb to Kaiser" cycling
7 event on Saturday, June 21, 2025; and

8 **WHEREAS**, the "Climb to Kaiser" event will involve over 16,000 feet of climbing during the 155-
9 mile route and has been rated by Bicycling Magazine as one of the Ten Toughest Rides in America;
10 and

11 **WHEREAS**, over 150 cyclists will attempt the Kaiser route which will take riders over such climbs
12 as Burrough Valley Road, Old Tollhouse Road, Huntington Lake Road, and Kaiser Pass Road; and


13 **WHEREAS**, participants from California and other surrounding states will be supported by almost
14 200 volunteers during this Fresno County event; and

15 **WHEREAS**, the Fresno Cycling Club has applied to the State of California to conduct the "Climb
16 to Kaiser" cycling event on State property; and the "Climb to Kaiser" event may temporarily impede and
17 restrict the free passage of traffic over State Highway Route 168 on Saturday, June 21, 2025, between
18 Clovis and Kaiser Pass between 5:30 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

19 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby
20 approves and consents to the proposed "Climb to Kaiser" cycling event and recommends approval of
21 and consents to the proposed restrictions of State Highway Route 168 upon terms and conditions
22 deemed appropriate and necessary by the State of California Department of Transportation.
