WHEREAS, the Committee was created to expand the public's experience with public art; make available to County residents artwork of the highest quality; integrate the design work of artists into the development of County projects regularly frequented by the general public; and, help create a more visually pleasing environment; and

WHEREAS, the Committee has not met in the past several years;

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Planning will work in consultation with the County department head of the specific new capital project for a County building or remodeling project of an existing County building, in excess of \$3 million, for the inclusion of public art, as deemed appropriate,

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Public Art Policy Committee is hereby abolished.
