**PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT**  
Exhibit A – Program Description and Funding

- I. **Program Objectives and Overview** - The Central Valley Suicide Prevention Hotline (CVSPH) will be administered through CalMHSA on behalf of counties that are participating in and funding the program. It will serve as the primary suicide prevention hotline for these counties. As funding allows, CVSPH will continue to operate a 24/7 suicide prevention hotline accredited by the American Association of Suicidology, and will continue to answer calls through its participation in the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. CVSPH will also maintain its hotline website, and will provide outreach and technical assistance to counties that are participating and funding the program. Based on county interest, additional activities may be added to this program and may include participating in the statewide Common Metrics program and expanding the hotline's ability to answer calls in other languages.

**Note on increased funding:** Fresno County is contributing an additional \$120,459.12 for the remainder of FY 17/18 to support the ongoing costs of CVSPH until June 30, 2018 and cover costs that were meant to be paid for by other sources of funding, including state funding.

- II. **Assignment of Funds** – Participant will assign an additional funding amount of \$120,459.12, for a total funding amount, not to exceed, \$426,075.00 to CalMHSA, as a fiscal intermediary, in the implementation of following the Central Valley Suicide Prevention Hotline program.

Upon cancellation, termination or other conclusion of this contract, any funds remaining undisbursed after CalMHSA satisfies all obligations arising from the administration of the Program shall be distributed to Participant.

- III. **Compensation for Administration** - CalMHSA will be paid an administration fee of 15% of total program funding.

**In the event of early termination due to dissolution of CalMHSA, CalMHSA will refund prepaid administrative fees equal to 15% of the undisbursed funds.**
