IN THE MATTER OF LOCAL TRANSPORTATION)
PURPOSE FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021) RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the County of Fresno is an eligible claimant of funds for Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds pursuant to California Public Utilities Code Section 142257; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Transportation Authority has adopted a Resolution of Apportionment for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds, setting the County of Fresno’s percentages at the following amounts:

- 26.25% of \$382,235 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – ADA Compliance Category sub program;
- 31.17% of \$573,267 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Bicycle Facilities sub program;
- 25.17% of \$10,990,932 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Flexible Funding Category sub program;
- 70.54% of \$391,756 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Pedestrian/Trails – Rural sub program;
- 06.20% of \$1,546,770 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Pedestrian/Trails – Urban sub program;
- 26.04% of \$11,007,248 for the Local Transportation Program, Local Allocation – Street Maintenance Category sub program;

which shall be the proportionate share of Measure C Extension Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds that the County shall be entitled to within the fiscal year.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- 2 1) The County of Fresno hereby submits its Local Transportation Purposes
3 Certification and Claims for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Measure C Extension
4 Local Transportation Pass-Through Projects and Program Funds;
- 5 2) The County of Fresno hereby requests the release of funds to the County
6 on a monthly payment basis consistent with the adopted percentages
7 listed above, based on actual receipts;
- 8 3) The Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno further certifies:
- 9 a) That Local Transportation Purpose Funds will not be used to
10 substitute for property tax funds which the County of Fresno had
11 previously used for local transportation purposes; and
- 12 b) That the County of Fresno has and will segregate property tax
13 revenues used to support local transportation purposes so that
14 verification of non-substitution can be proved through audit and:
- 15 c) That the County of Fresno shall separately account for Local
16 Transportation Purposes Funds received, pursuant to Public
17 Utilities Code Section 142257. The County shall maintain records
18 in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles, and
19 shall separately record expenditures for each type of eligible
20 purpose. The County shall make such records available to the
21 Authority for inspection or audit at any time.
- 22 4) The County of Fresno understands that should a financial or
23 compliance audit reveal that the County of Fresno violated any of the
requirements set forth in paragraph 3 (a) (b) or (c), that the Fresno
County Transportation Authority may seek to take immediate steps to
resolve the violation in accordance with its adopted procedures.

1 5) The County of Fresno understands that reporting requirements for the
2 previous fiscal year's funds must be completed no later than November
3 15, 2020, to avoid the withholding of monthly disbursements.


