RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California’s (state) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the various CalRecycle grant programs allow for both individual and regional grant projects; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant’s governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO (BOARD) authorizes submittal of applications for the various CalRecycle grant programs, identified in Exhibit “A”, as follows:

1. EITHER on behalf of itself as Lead Agency and the participating jurisdictions, attached hereto as Exhibit “B”, OR
2. As an individual applicant of the grant program(s); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CHAIRMAN OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS (CHAIRMAN), or his/her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute on behalf of County of Fresno (COUNTY) and the participating jurisdictions all grant-related documents including, but not limited to, applications, payment requests, agreements, and amendments necessary to secure grant funds and to implement the approved grant project(s); and

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1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CHAIRMAN'S designee, and THE DIRECTOR
2 OF PUBLIC WORKS AND PLANNING, are hereby authorized and empowered to execute on
3 behalf of the COUNTY and the participating jurisdictions all grant-related documents necessary
4 to secure grant funds and to implement the approved grant project(s), excepting only the Grant
5 Agreement and any subsequent amendments thereto, which shall be executed on behalf of the
6 COUNTY only by the CHAIRMAN in accordance with the following provisions hereof; and

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CHAIRMAN is hereby authorized to execute said
8 Grant Agreement on behalf of the COUNTY upon its receipt and presentation for the
9 CHAIRMAN's signature by Department of Public Works and Planning staff ("Staff") without any
10 further action by the BOARD provided that the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement are
11 represented by Staff to be substantially identical to those contained in predecessor Grant
12 Agreements for the Specified Programs; and

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any amendment(s) to the Grant Agreements that may
14 be proposed subsequent to execution of the Grant Agreement by the CHAIRMAN in accordance
15 with the immediately preceding paragraph, as well as any Grant Agreement that is not
16 represented by Staff to be substantially identical to the predecessor Grant Agreement in
17 accordance with the immediately preceding paragraph, shall be executed by the CHAIRMAN
18 only following appropriate review and approval of such proposed amendment by the BOARD;
19 and

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these authorizations are and shall remain effective for
21 a period of five (5) years from the date of adoption of this resolution.


