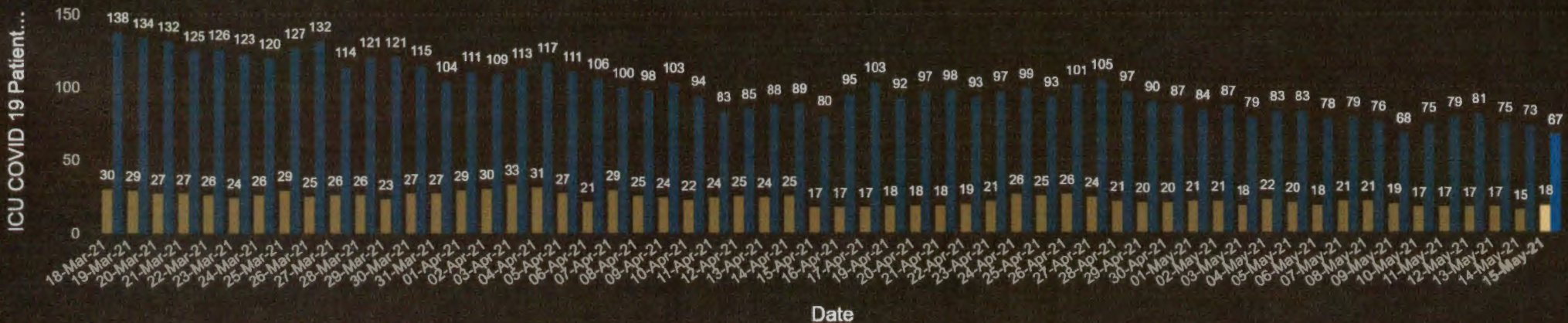

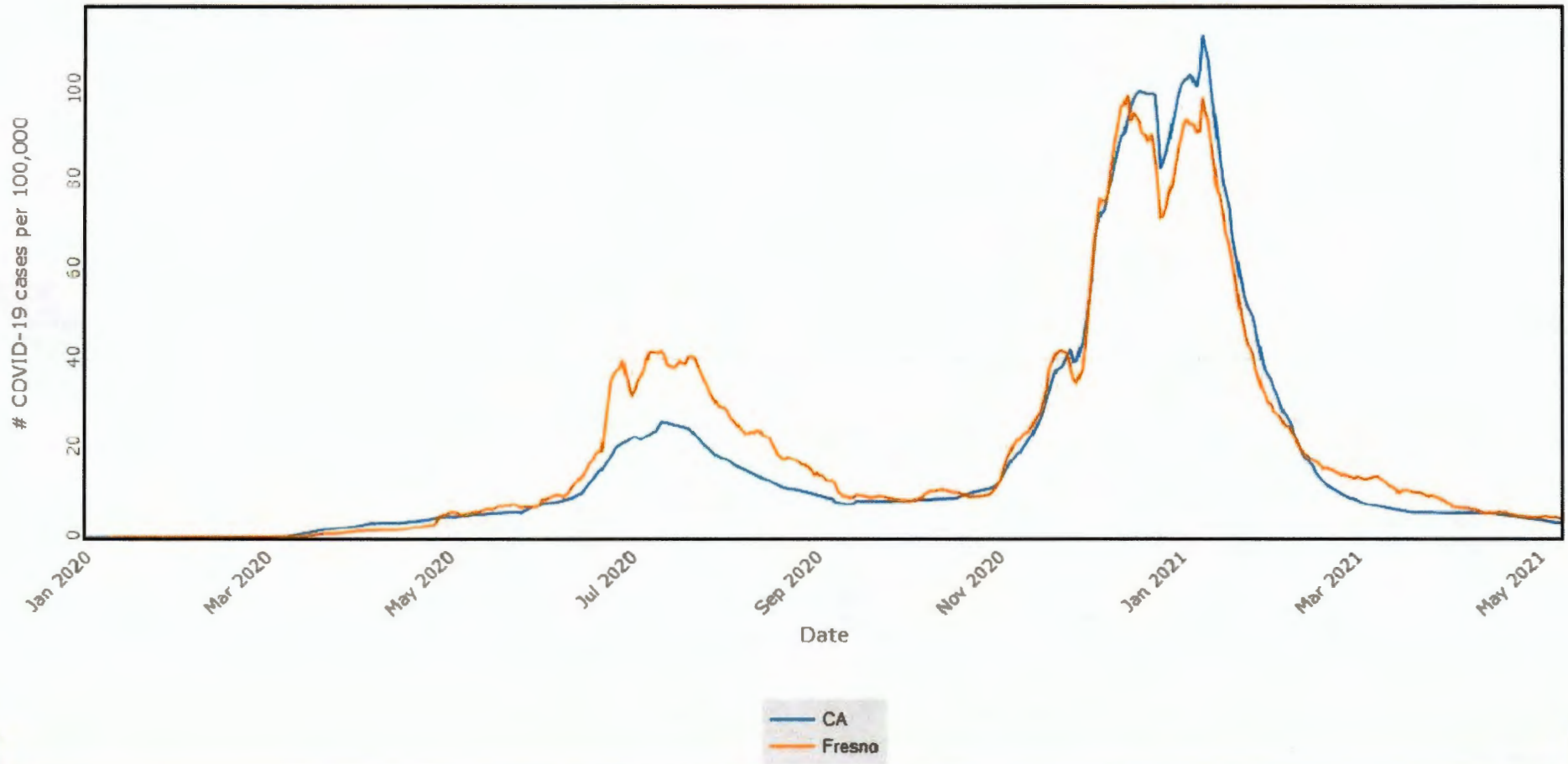

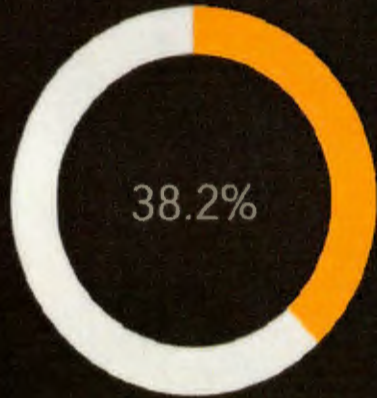

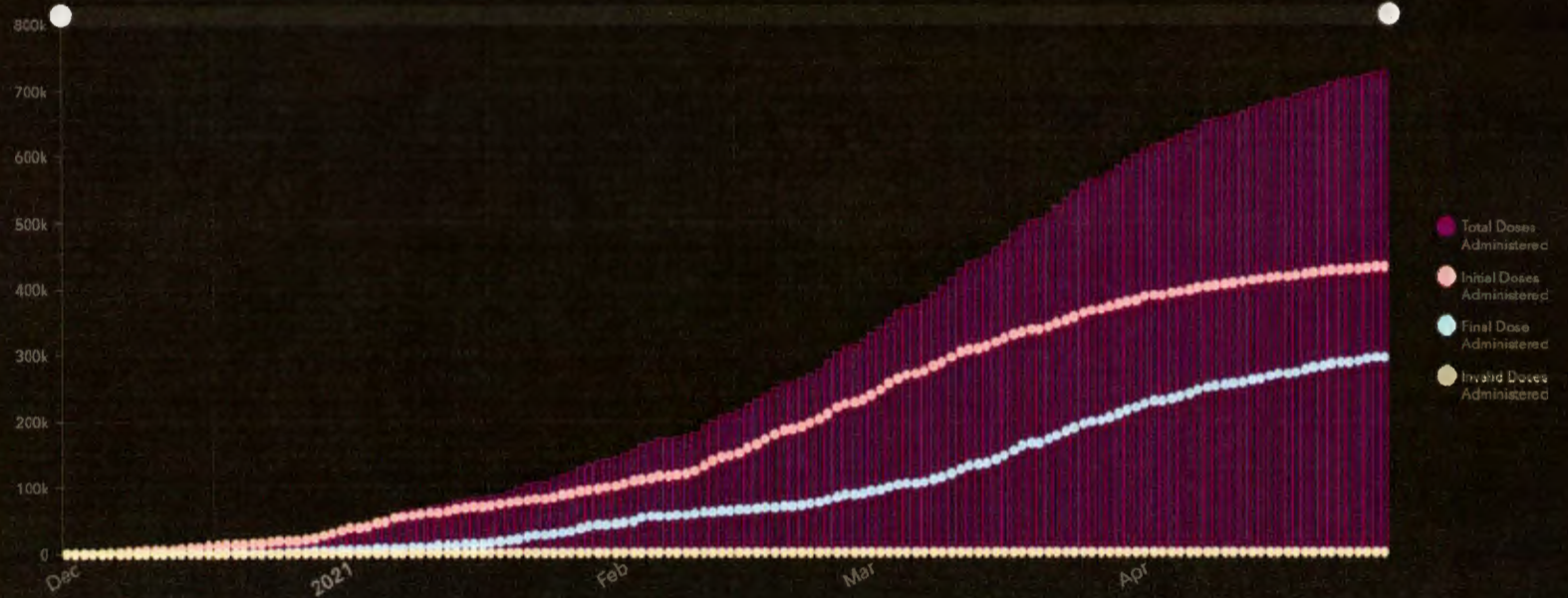

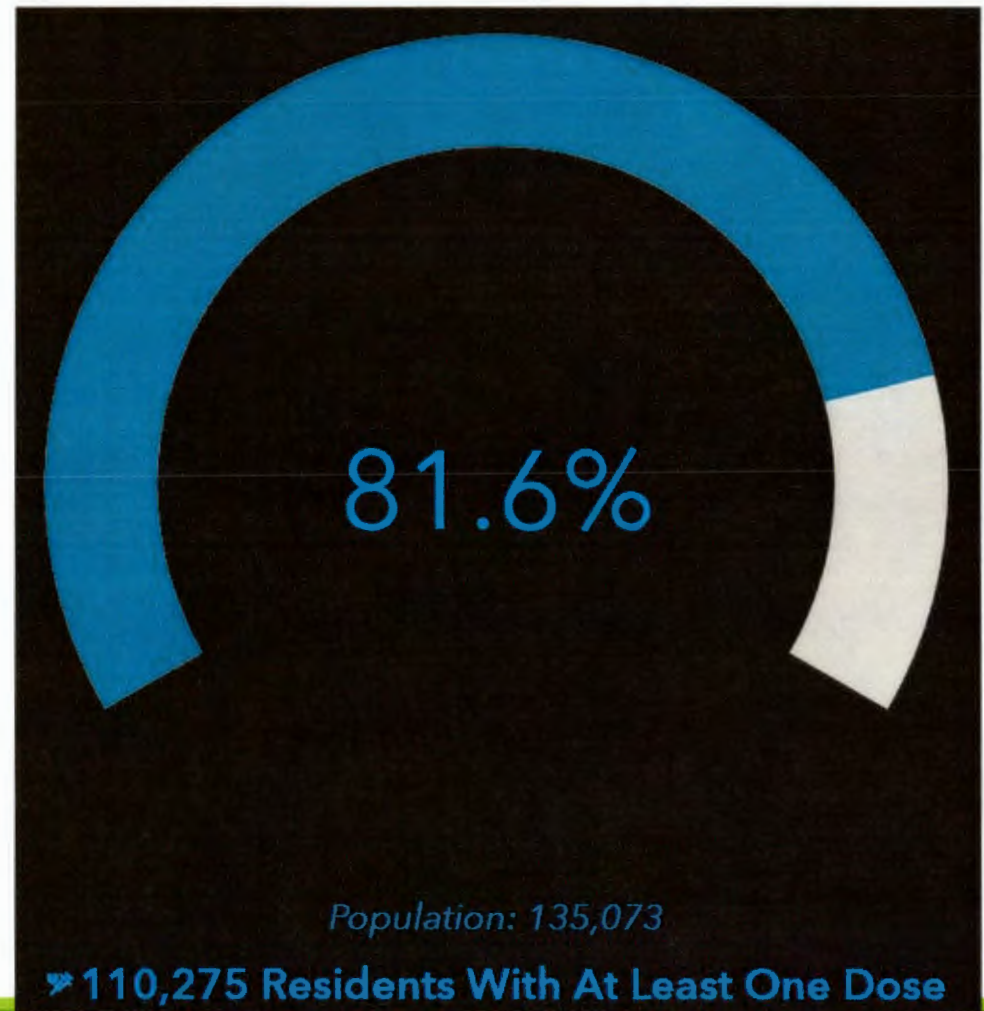

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# What comes after June 15<sup>th</sup>?

- Optimize testing for outbreak control strategies
- Guidelines for safer gatherings and crowded public settings
- Masking Guidance – statewide changes anticipated
- Safe Schools for All Program
  - Goal to return to School 5-days a week
  - State funded support for testing/vaccines/PPE/renovations
