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Section 2. That the County Administrative Officer, or other officer or employee of the County designated in writing by the Board of Supervisors to the CDTFA, is hereby appointed to represent the County with authority to examine those sales and use tax records of the CDTFA, for purposes related to the following governmental functions of the County, including but not limited to:

- a) County administration
- b) revenue management
- c) economic analysis

The information obtained by examination of CDTFA records shall be used only for those governmental functions of the County listed above.

Section 3. That Hinderliter, de Llamas and Associates is hereby designated to examine the sales and use tax records of the CDTFA pertaining to sales and use taxes collected for the County by the CDTFA. The person or entity designated by this section meets all of the following conditions:

- a) Has an existing contract with the County to examine those sales and use tax records;
- b) Is required by that contract to disclose information contained in, or derived from, those sales and use tax records only to the officer or employee authorized under Section 1 of this resolution to examine the information.
- c) Is prohibited by that contract from performing consulting services for a retailer during the term of that contract; and
- d) Is prohibited by that contract from retaining the information contained in, or derived from those sales and use tax records. after that contract has expired.

The information obtained by examination of CDTFA records shall be used only for purposes related to the collection of County sales and use taxes by the CDTFA pursuant to the contract between the County and the CDTFA, and for purposes

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relating to the governmental functions of the County listed in section 2 of this resolution.

Section 4. That this resolution supersedes all prior resolutions of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno adopted pursuant to subdivision (b) of Revenue and Taxation Code Section 7056.
