

December 18, 2025: FCOG Policy Board to vote on Implementation Guidelines

Staff Suggested Revisions to Implementation Guidelines

- Establish a subcommittee of County and City transportation staff to develop a revised 2026
 Measure C Implementation Guidelines
- Increase the Local Neighborhood Streets and Roads allocation from 65% to 70%
- Increase the Regional Transportation Program allocation from 5% to 18%
- Revision to County's Set-Aside annual allocation of \$5 million for Disadvantaged Communities
- Revisions to 70 PCI Requirements
- Remove reference in the Implementation Guidelines to Vehicle Miles Traveled
- Clarify the audit protocols

RENEWAL BALLOT PROCESS

Expenditure Plan Approved by **FCOG Policy Board**.

Expenditure Plan approved by **City Councils** representing a majority of the incorporated population.

Expenditure Plan must be Approved by **Board of Supervisors.**

Expenditure Plan must be approved by Fresno County Transportation Authority.

Measure requires **66.67%** of the vote to pass. (2022 Measure failed with **58.2%**)

CITIZEN INITIATIVE BALLOT PROCESS

Proponent state their intention to gather signatures for an initiative.

Citizen initiatives require 22,000+ valid signatures.

Board of Supervisors required to place on ballot.

Measure passes with simple majority vote.
