## 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO CONSULTANT AGREEMENT

2 This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment No. 1") to Consultant Agreement No. A-20-514  
3 ("Agreement"), is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2025, by and between the  
4 County of Fresno, a political subdivision of the State of California ("County"), and Area West  
5 Environmental, Inc., (a California Corporation), whose address is 6248 Main Avenue, Suite #C,  
6 Orangevale, CA 95662 ("Consultant").

7 RECITALS

8 A. On December 15, 2020, the County and the Consultant entered into a Consultant  
9 Agreement, which is County Agreement Number A-20-514 for Environmental Consultant Services.

10 B. The Consultant has been selected to provide specialized professional environmental  
11 consulting services required for the California Environmental Quality Act and National Environmental  
12 Policy Act approval of the North Fork Road Bridge over San Joaquin River Replacement Project  
13 ("Project").

14 C. The Consultant has been selected in accordance with the County's Ordinance Code  
15 Chapter 4.10 on the Selection of Architects, Engineers, and Other Professionals and Chapter 10 of the  
16 California Department of Transportation (CALTRANS) Local Assistance Procedures Manual, Consultant  
17 Selection, to provide the environmental services necessary for the Project.

18 D. The County and the Consultant now desire to amend the Agreement to increase the  
19 maximum contract amount by \$260,504.75 thereby bringing the total not-to-exceed contract amount to  
20 \$934,188.75.

21 The parties therefore agree as follows:

22 1. Article IV, Section A of the Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

23 "A. This Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement shall go into effect upon execution by the  
24 County. The Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement shall continue in effect for a period of  
25 ten years commencing on the execution date, unless prior to its expiration its term is  
26 extended in writing, for a maximum of one (1) additional one-year term, by mutual  
27 consent of the Director and the Consultant.

2. Article V, Section A, Part 2 of the Agreement is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

"2. The Total amount payable by the County shall not exceed \$934,188.75 for actual and indirect costs."
3. A revised cost for the Project is detailed in Exhibit L, attached hereto, and incorporated by this reference, and which, commencing upon and continuing after the Effective Date of this Amendment No. 1.

**Cost Assumptions:**

1. Preconstruction surveys assume 4 field days in one season; if surveys must be repeated due to pause in activity or new season, added cost would be incurred.
2. Biological monitoring estimated for 62 days total (assumes 3 weeks daily monitoring during initial ground disturbance/dewatering, once weekly for 45 weeks)
3. No cultural resources or archaeological monitoring would be needed. Cost for cultural services does not include Phase II Evaluation and/or Data Recovery efforts.
4. Contractor will prepare and implement the Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP); no SWPPP monitoring is included in this cost.
