WHEREAS, the State of California – Military Department has donated three buildings, the Armory building with an estimated useful life value of \$3,004,320 , the Butler building with an estimated useful life value of \$99,900, and the Fuel Maintenance and Support (FMS) building with an estimated useful life value of \$238,980, located at 911 S. Chance, Fresno CA 93702, together commonly referred to as the National Guard Armory which have a combined estimated useful life value of approximately \$3,343,200, to the County of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, County staff is working with the 21<sup>st</sup> District Agricultural Association to include the Armory building into their existing lease agreement with the County; and


WHEREAS, County staff is also working to repurpose the Butler and FMS building for County use.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby ACCEPTS said donation from the State of California – Military Department and that the Board EXPRESSES ITS GRATITUDE for support of Fresno County.


