AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MARCH 5, 2024 IN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE ELECTORS A MEASURE TO AMEND SECTION 15 OF THE CHARTER OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO AND ORDERING CONSOLIDATION OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION WITH THE STATEWIDE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE SAME DAY.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno ordains as follows:

Section 1. A special election is hereby called, ordered, and proclaimed to be held in the County of Fresno ("County") on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the County a measure to amend Section 15 of the County Charter.

Section 2. The exact form of the measure as it will appear on the ballot is as follows:

Shall the measure amending section 15 of the Fresno County Charter to keep the election dates for the office of Sheriff and District Attorney set in gubernatorial, non-presidential election years with other County elective offices be adopted?

The complete text of the measure is set forth in Resolution No. 23-287, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on August 22, 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto in Attachment A. **Section 3.** In the event that the amendment to the County Charter contained in this measure is rendered inoperative because of actions of any court, legislative or other body, or for any other reason, the provisions of the County Charter in effect on Tuesday, March 5, 2024 will remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. If any sentence, clause, phrase, or word of the County Charter amendment measure is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforceable, such invalidity or unenforceability will not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining sentences, clauses, phrases, or words of Section 15 of the County Charter. The voters of the County declare that they would have independently adopted each sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this measure irrespective of the fact that any one or more other sentences, clauses, phrases, or words of Section 15 of the County Charter is declared invalid or unenforceable.

Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors resolves and orders the special election for the County Charter amendment measure to be consolidated with the Statewide Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. The measure will be placed on the same ballot as provided for in the Statewide Primary Election. The precincts, polling places or vote centers, and precinct board members will be the same as provided for in the Statewide Primary Election. The special election will be held in the manner specified in California Elections Code Section 10418 as an election consolidated with a statewide election.

Section 6. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 12001, the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims that a special countywide election will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, to vote on the proposed County Charter amendment measure.

Section 7. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 9141 and California Government Code Section 25123, this ordinance shall take effect immediately.

Section 8. The ordinance is adopted pursuant to California Government Code Sections 23720. 23730, and 23731 and California Elections Code Sections 9141, 10402, 10403, and 12001.

Section 9. The ordinance must be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the ordinance, before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage in a daily

2	California Government Code Section 25124.
3	The Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is ordered to file a copy of this ordinance with the
4	County Clerk/Registrar of Voters at least 88 days prior to the day of the election.

12	WHEREAS, California Government Code Sections 23720(a) and 23722 pern	ni	
13	a county board of supervisors to propose amendment to the county charter and to		
14	submit the amendment to the eligible registered voters of the county at a special

17	WHEREAS, the California Constitution, Article XI, Section 4, grants to charte	r	
18	counties such as the County of Fresno the authority to provide in their charters for		
19	"[a]n elected sheriff, an elected district attorney, an elected assessor, other officers,		
20	their election or appointment, compensation, terms and removal." (Cal. Const. Art.)	ΚI,

22	WHEREAS, the California Legislature passed AB 759, effective January 1,		
23	2023, adding Section 1300 to the California Elections Code purporting to set the		
24	election date for Sheriffs and District Attorneys in presidential election years in non-		
25	charter counties and in charter counties that did not specifically establish election		
26	dates in their charters on or before January 1, 2021; and		
27	WHEREAS, new Elections Code Section 1300 is unconstitutional under		

California Constitution Article XI, Section 4, (c) and (g); and

WHEREAS, new Elections Code Section 1300 would have the effect of extending the current terms of the Sheriff and District Attorney in the County of Fresno to six years rather than the four year terms to which the incumbents to those offices were elected, without legal basis or the consent of the voters of the County of Fresno; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors proposes to amend Charter Section 15 to establish the election dates for Sheriff and District Attorney to be held in gubernatorial, non-presidential election years as previously done in the County of Fresno, keeping all elected County officials elections together in gubernatorial election years except for those Supervisorial districts on alternating election cycles; and

WHEREAS, a Statewide Primary Election will be held on March 5, 2024; and WHEREAS, pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10400 *et seq.*, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors seeks consolidation of the countywide special election on the charter amendment measure with the March 5, 2024 Statewide Primary Election; and

WHEREAS, under California Elections Code Sections 10400 *et seq.*, the Fresno County Board of Supervisors has the power and authority to order the consolidation of local elections with the Statewide Primary Election.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

- The Board of Supervisors hereby calls, orders, and proclaims a special election to be held in the County of Fresno on March 5, 2024 for the purpose of submitting to the voters of the County the charter amendment measure pursuant to California Elections Code Sections 10403 and 12001.
- 2. Pursuant to California Elections Code Section 10400 et seq., the Board of Supervisors hereby directs and approves the special election for the charter amendment measure to be placed on the ballot for the March 5, 2024 Statewide Primary Election and be consolidated with that election.

- The Board of Supervisors acknowledges that the consolidated election will be held and conducted in the manner prescribed in California Elections Code Section 10418.
- 4. The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters is designated as the elections official for the election, and the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters is hereby authorized and directed to provide all notices and take any and all other actions necessary to holding the election, including but not limited to providing notices of times within which arguments for and against are submitted.
- 5. The ballot question hereby approved for said election shall be as follows:

Shall the measure amending section 15 of the Fresno County Charter to keep the election dates for the office of Sheriff and District Attorney set in gubernatorial, non-presidential election years with other County elective offices be adopted?

- 6. The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters is hereby authorized and directed to cause the complete text of the proposed charter amendment to be printed as indicated in the attached Exhibit A in the County of Fresno Voter Information Guide, and a copy of the proposed amendment shall be made available to a voter upon request.
- 7. The charter amendment measure shall be designated on the ballot by a letter, as provided in California Elections Code Section 13116.
- 8. Arguments in favor of and in opposition to the charter amendment measure and rebuttal arguments shall be permitted and shall be filed with the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters in accordance with applicable provisions of the California Elections Code, including Sections 9161 through 9167 thereof. As provided in California Elections Code Section 9162, the Board of Supervisors or any member or members of the Board of Supervisors are

hereby authorized to act as an author of any ballot argument prepared in connection with the charter amendment measure election.

9. The Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters shall fix the dates for submittal of arguments and rebuttals as provided for in the California Elections Code. The Board of Supervisors requests that the Fresno County Clerk/Registrar of Voters fix the dates for submittal of arguments and rebuttals after October 10, 2023.

EXHIBIT A

Shall Section 15 of the County of Fresno Charter be amended to read:

SECTION 15

All elective officers shall be nominated and elected at the time and in the manner and for the terms now or hereafter provided by general law

Members of the Board of Supervisors shall be nominated and elected at the time and in the manner for the terms now or hereinafter provided by general law. All elective officers other than members of the Board of Supervisors shall be nominated and elected for four-year terms in the year in which the Governor of the State of California is elected, in the manner provided for by general law concerning primaries and general elections. Nothing in this section shall extend or shorten the four-year term being served by any elected officer of the county at the time of the adoption of this section. Nothing in this section shall change or amend any provision in this Charter governing the filling of vacancies in elective county offices.
