RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Bethel and South Avenues, making it an all-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Bethel and South Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Bethel and South Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Bethel and South Avenues, stopping eastbound and westbound traffic on South Avenue and making the intersection an all-way stop.

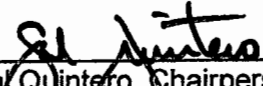

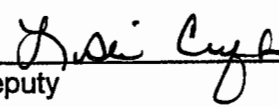
