SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO

The City of Fresno is preparing street improvement plans that will require the dedication/perfecting of existing prescriptive right-of-way for public street easement purposes within the County of Fresno in conjunction with the street improvements along Dakota Avenue between Cornelia Avenue and Blythe Avenue as shown on the enclosed exhibits.

The proposed area of dedication and construction of street improvements are within the County jurisdiction. The City requests that the County of Fresno grant the City the authority to perfect existing prescriptive right-of-way, excluding eminent domain condemnation actions, from parcels adjacent to existing County right-of-way in an identified unincorporated area of the County as needed in conjunction with the City's development of street and intersection improvements on the south side of Dakota Avenue, at and near the intersection of Milburn Avenue, in the area generally bounded by Cornelia and Blythe Avenues.

The City agrees that maintenance of the improvements can best be performed by one agency, and the City agrees to perform all maintenance for the improvements installed within the area.
