WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that stop signs be installed at the intersection of Belmont and Blythe Avenues, making it an all-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Belmont and Blythe Avenues is under the exclusive jurisdiction of the County of Fresno.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the intersection of Belmont and Blythe Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of stop signs at the intersection of Belmont and Blythe Avenues, stopping eastbound and westbound traffic on Belmont Avenue.
