SUBJECT: REQUEST TO ACQUIRE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE COUNTY OF FRESNO

The City of Fresno has received funds from the federal Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program (CMAQ) for improvements at the intersection of McKinley & Blythe Avenues, including construction of a full traffic signal, sidewalk along the north side of McKinley, adjacent to McKinley Elementary, and bike lanes throughout the project's limits of work. As the project will be installing sidewalk and other improvements at the intersections of McKinley & Blythe and Weldon & Blythe which include minor expansions of the public right-of-way, there will be a small amount of encroachment outside the existing street right-of-way onto private property currently owned by Central Unified School District and Fresno County residents, as shown in the enclosed exhibits.

The proposed areas of construction of street and traffic signal improvements are partially within the County jurisdiction and as such, the City requests the County of Fresno grant the City authority to acquire these dedications of the public street right-of-way on behalf of the County.
