WHEREAS, the Capital Facilities Org 1055 requires \$50,000 to meet expenditures associated with the Adult Crisis Residential Treatment Facility construction project; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Facilities Org 1055 requires an increase in appropriations to fund an Operating Transfer Out in the amount of \$50,000 to the Behavioral Health Org 5630; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Fund Balance of the Mental Health Services Act Special Revenue Fund 0040, Subclass 17105 to fund these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, \$50,000 is not included in the FY 2016-17 adopted appropriations of the Capital Facilities Org 1055; and


WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2016-17 Capital Facilities Org 1055 as follows:


