
2.38.030 County strategic plan—revisions—annual audit and report.

- A. The commission shall adopt a county strategic plan for the support and improvement of early childhood development within the County of Fresno. The county strategic plan shall be consistent with and in furtherance of the purposes of the Act and any guidelines adopted by the California Children and Families Commission pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 130125(b), that are in effect at the time the plan is adopted. The county strategic plan shall, at a minimum, include the following: a description of the goals and objectives proposed to be attained; a description of the programs, services, and projects proposed to be provided, sponsored, or facilitated; and a description of how measurable outcomes of such programs, services, and projects will be determined by the commission using appropriate indicators. The county strategic plan shall not be deemed adequate or complete until and unless the plan describes how programs, services and projects relating to early childhood development within the County of Fresno will be integrated into a consumer-oriented and easily accessible system.
- B. Prior to adoption of its strategic plan, the commission shall (1) conduct at least one public hearing on its proposed county strategic plan; (2) present its proposed strategic plan to the board of supervisors as a regular item on the agenda of a regularly scheduled board of supervisors meeting; and (3) receive and consider comments the county has received as a result of a 45-day public comment period. The commission shall submit the adopted strategic plan to the board of supervisors and California Children and Families Commission.
- C. The commission shall, on an annual basis, review the county strategic plan and prepare proposed revisions as may be necessary. Prior to adoption of any proposed revision to the strategic plan, the commission shall (1) conduct at least one public hearing on any proposed revision to the county strategic plan; (2) present its proposed revision of the strategic plan to the board of supervisors as a regular item on the agenda of a regularly scheduled board of supervisors meeting; and (3) receive and consider comments the county has received as a result of a forty-five-day public comment period. Following adoption by the commission, the commission shall submit its approved revisions to the strategic plan to the board of supervisors and California Children and Families Commission.
- D. The commission shall prepare and adopt an annual audit pursuant to the Health and Safety Code § 130150. Prior to adoption, the commission shall present its annual audit to the Fresno County Audit Committee for review and comment. The commission shall conduct a public hearing on the proposed annual audit. Following adoption, the annual audit shall be presented to the board of supervisors as a regular **or consent** item on the agenda of a regularly scheduled board of supervisors meeting on or before October 1 of each year. The annual audit shall be submitted to the California Children and Families Commission.
- E. The commission shall prepare and adopt an annual report pursuant to Health and Safety Code § 130150. Prior to adoption, the commission shall conduct a public hearing on the proposed annual report. The commission shall submit its adopted annual report to the board of supervisors at a regularly scheduled board of supervisors meeting prior to the fiscal year during which it is to be used by the commission. The annual report shall be submitted to the California Children and Families Commission.
