WHEREAS, the Sheriff’s Local Law Enforcement Block Organization 1456 requires \$38,234 to meet FY 2022-23 estimated revenue transfers associated with the Justice Assistance grant formerly known as Local Law Enforcement Block grant; and

WHEREAS, \$164,563 is available in the fund balance of the Sheriff-Coroner Special Revenue Fund 0095, Subclass 17655 to fund these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, said monies are not included in the FY 2022-23 adopted appropriations and estimated revenues of the Local Law Enforcement Block Org 1456; and


WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2022-23 Local Law Enforcement Block Org 1456 as follows:
