Presented before your Board today is an item to consider and take action on a request for determination of public convenience or necessity on application for Type 21 Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) License filed by Beal Developments, LLC dba Beal Chevron.

- * License Type 21 (Off-Sale General): Authorizes the sale of beer, wine and distilled spirits for consumption off the premises where sold.

FRESNO COUNTY POLICY MANAGEMENT DIRECTIVE 2400

County policy requires the following criteria to be considered before a determination of public convenience or necessity can be met:

1. The issuance of a license would not tend to create a law enforcement problem and increase the level of crime activity.
2. The issuance of a license would provide a needed service to the community and that without this use there would be an inconvenience to the community.
3. The issuance of a license will have a positive impact on the local economy including the creation of new jobs.

The determination of public convenience and necessity alone does not guarantee the applicant will receive a license from CDABC. The issuance of a license is totally within the discretion of the CDABC, and the applicant must also comply with other requirements of CDABC and other applicable land use and health and safety code requirements.

- * The Fresno County Sheriff's Department was contacted and reviewed this application. Staff is available for questions.



STATISTICS


