19-0312 Resolution No. 20-019 BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS 1 OF THE COUNTY OF FRESNO 2 STATE OF CALIFORNIA 3 IN THE MATTER OF: 4 UTILITY RELOCATION IN LATON COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT 5 RESOLUTION 6 WHEREAS the County of Fresno has secured federal grant funding through the Active 7 Transportation Program to widen existing roads and concrete culverts, construct curb, gutters 8 and sidewalks, and install a new storm drain system in some areas of the community of Laton 9 (Project); 10 WHEREAS, the Laton Community Service District (Laton CSD) provides water 11 distribution and wastewater collection services, among other services, to the community of 12 Laton. Existing water and sewer lines run within the County's road right of way, throughout the 13 limits of the Project; 14 WHEREAS, the existing water and sewer infrastructure was designed, bid, and awarded 15 by the County of Fresno on behalf of Laton CSD, and upon completion and acceptance, Laton 16 CSD took ownership of the water and sewer facilities; 17 WHEREAS, this Project will require relocation of existing water meters along Bliss 18 Avenue and Gonser Street, the relocation of water distribution facilities along Bliss Ave, and the 19 adjustment of existing sewer manhole lids, because they are in conflict with the proposed 20 improvements, and relocation of existing sewer lines and appurtenant facilities near the Grant 21 Canal and "A" ditch (collectively, "Water and Sewer Facilities"); a diagram of the Water and 22 Sewer Facilities to be relocated is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference; 23 WHEREAS, there were no encroachment permits issued at the time (no conditions of 24 approval), and no stipulations agreed to by the Laton CSD to relocate or adjust these Water and 25 Sewer Facilities in the event there were street improvements: 26 WHEREAS, the Supplemental Map of the Town of Laton, recorded November 6, 1901, 27

states that, "the streets and avenues shown on this map are for public uses";

WHEREAS, Laton CSD does not currently have funds available to pay the costs

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associated with the relocation of these Water and Sewer Facilities; 1 2 WHEREAS, the completion of this Project will result in a public benefit to the community 3 of Laton, and the County of Fresno is agreeable to paying the costs associated with the 4 relocation of these Water and Sewer Facilities. NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, because the Project is for public use, which will 5 6 benefit the community of Laton, and the Project will require relocation of Laton CSD's Water and 7 Sewer Facilities, and Laton CSD is unable to pay the costs associated with the relocation of the 8 Water and Sewer Facilities, the County agrees to be financially responsible for the costs of 9 relocation of the Water and Sewer Facilities in conflict with the Project. 10 IT IS HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that County will execute a utility agreement with Laton CSD for the relocation work to be performed. 11 12 THE FOREGOING, was passed and adopted by the following vote of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno this 21st day of January 13 2020, to wit; 14 AYES: Supervisors Brandau, Magsig, Mendes, Pacheco, Quintero 15 NOES: None 16 None ABSENT: 17 None ABSTAINED: 18 19 20 Ernest Buddy Mendes, Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno 21 22 ATTEST: Bernice E. 
