OF MADISON AVENUE AND WINERY AVENUE)

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Planning, on the basis of a traffic engineering study, has recommended that a stop sign be installed at the "T" intersection of Madison Avenue and Winery Avenue, making it a one-way stop.

WHEREAS, the intersection of Madison and Winery Avenues is under the shared jurisdiction between the County of Fresno and the City of Fresno, with the west side of Winery Avenue under City of Fresno jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors is designating the "T" intersection of Madison and Winery Avenues a stop intersection and authorizing the installation of a stop sign at the intersection of Madison Avenue and Winery Avenue, stopping westbound traffic on Madison Avenue.

THE FOREGOING, was passed and adopted by the following vote of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Fresno this 29th day of January 2019, to wit:

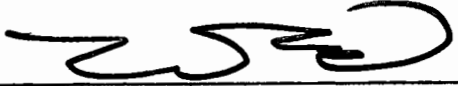

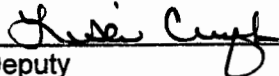
