

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Amendment No. 1 to Service Agreement (“Amendment No. 1”) is dated April 7, 2026 and is between Superior Court of California, County of Fresno, an entity of the California Judicial Branch organized under Article VI of the California Constitution, whose address is 1100 Van Ness, Fresno, CA 93724-0002 (“Court”), and the County of Fresno, a political subdivision of the State of California (“County”).

Recitals

A. On July 18, 2023, the County and the Court entered into a service agreement, which is County agreement number 23-357 (“Agreement”), for Odyssey system access, door access, Wi-Fi usage, badges, and printer usage.

B. The Odyssey system is a case management system (CMS) that County departments utilize to access case types including criminal, civil, probate, family, and juvenile cases.

C. The Court transitioned its CMS from Odyssey to e-Court effective April 1, 2026.

D. The Court and the County now desire to amend the Agreement solely to update references to the Court’s CMS to reflect this transition.

The parties therefore agree as follows:

1. This Amendment No. 1 shall be retroactive to April 1, 2026.

2. All references in the Agreement to the Court’s “Odyssey” case management system are hereby deleted and replaced with “case management system”.

3. When both parties have signed this Amendment No. 1, the Agreement, and this Amendment No. 1 together constitute the Agreement.

4. The Court represents and warrants to the County that:

a. The Court is duly authorized and empowered to sign and perform its obligations under this Amendment.

b. The individual signing this Amendment on behalf of the Court is duly authorized to do so and his or her signature on this Amendment legally binds the Court to the terms of this Amendment.

1 5. The parties agree that this Amendment may be executed by electronic signature as
2 provided in this section.

3 a. An "electronic signature" means any symbol or process intended by an individual
4 signing this Amendment to represent their signature, including but not limited to (1) a
5 digital signature; (2) a faxed version of an original handwritten signature; or (3) an
6 electronically scanned and transmitted (for example by PDF document) version of an
7 original handwritten signature.

8 b. Each electronic signature affixed or attached to this Amendment (1) is deemed
9 equivalent to a valid original handwritten signature of the person signing this
10 Amendment for all purposes, including but not limited to evidentiary proof in any
11 administrative or judicial proceeding, and (2) has the same force and effect as the
12 valid original handwritten signature of that person.

13 c. The provisions of this section satisfy the requirements of Civil Code section 1633.5,
14 subdivision (b), in the Uniform Electronic Transaction Act (Civil Code, Division 3, Part
15 2, Title 2.5, beginning with section 1633.1).

16 d. Each party using a digital signature represents that it has undertaken and satisfied
17 the requirements of Government Code section 16.5, subdivision (a), paragraphs (1)
18 through (5), and agrees that each other party may rely upon that representation.

19 e. This Amendment is not conditioned upon the parties conducting the transactions
20 under it by electronic means and either party may sign this Amendment with an
21 original handwritten signature.

22 6. This Amendment may be signed in counterparts, each of which is an original, and all of
23 which together constitute this Amendment.

24 7. The Agreement as amended by this Amendment No. 1 is ratified and continued. All
25 provisions of the Agreement and not amended by this Amendment No. 1 remain in full force and
26 effect.





