WHEREAS, the Mental Health (Managed Care) Org 5636 requires \$3,000,000 to meet expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the Mental Health (Managed Care) Org 5636 requires an increase in appropriations to fund an Operating Transfer Out in the amount of \$3,000,000 to the Behavioral Health Org 5630; and

WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the Fund Balance of the Local Revenue Fund 2011 0271, Subclass 13030, Org 5636 to fund these expenditures; and

WHEREAS, said monies were not included in the adopted appropriations for the FY 2018-19 Mental Health (Managed Care) Org 5636.

WHEREAS, Section 29130 of the Government Code provides for the appropriation of these funds by a 4/5 vote of the Board of Supervisors;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Auditor-Controller/Treasurer-Tax Collector is authorized to increase the appropriations in the FY 2018-19 Mental Health (Managed Care) Org 5636 as follows:
