WHEREAS, the County maintains Huntington Lake Road; and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2017, residents informed the County that there appeared to be road damage at Huntington Lake Road at Line Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works and Planning – Road Maintenance and Operations staff removed the snow from the road to get to the location and assess the damage; and

WHEREAS, there were present and immediate need for preservation of public health, welfare, and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works and Planning, in conjunction with the County Administrative Officer, declared the situation to be an emergency; and

WHEREAS, contractors were engaged to perform work necessary for taking the steps to protect County property; and

WHEREAS, the nature of the emergencies are such that immediate road repair was necessary; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that all of the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the procurement of services to provide for the repair of County property without competitive bidding was in the best interest of the County due to the immediate need to obtain services for the protection of County property.


