SECURITY OFFICER CARLOS PEREZ )**

**WHEREAS**, on February 22, 2023, an elderly member of the public suffered a medical emergency while receiving services in the County Clerk's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, Senior Security Officer Carlos Perez responded to the scene within seconds of receiving a call for assistance, found that the victim was non-responsive, not breathing, did not have a pulse and Officer Perez immediately began administering CPR; and

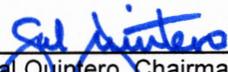
**WHEREAS**, Officer Carlos Perez performed CPR on the victim for seven minutes straight until Emergency Medical Services and Fresno Fire Department arrived at the scene. Meanwhile, multiple members of ISD – Security maintained crowd control, secured and cleared the area, and escorted Emergency Medical Services and the Fresno Fire Department to the victim; and

**WHEREAS**, the victim regained a pulse and signs of life by the time Emergency Medical Services and Fresno Fire Department transported him to the hospital due to the quick response administered by Officer Carlos Perez.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby recognize Officer Carlos Perez for his selflessness and immediate response to a medical emergency suffered by a member of the public.
