WHEREAS, Phillip Ferdolage, retired as a Road Operations Lead Supervisor effective September 28, 2024, at 5:00 p.m., and

WHEREAS, the County Road Maintenance and Operations Division will have a vacant Road Operations Lead Supervisor position; and

WHEREAS, the Road Operations Lead Supervisor position is critical to the development of Fresno County's FY2024-25 Recommended Budget; and

WHEREAS, Government Code section 7522.56 requires a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period, as established by the California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act, unless the employer's governing body finds and certifies the nature of the employment, and that the appointment is necessary to fill a critically needed position before the one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period has passed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Fresno County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this Resolution to hire extra-help retiree Phillip Ferdolage as Road Operations Lead Supervisor on an as-needed basis, effective February 3, 2025, finding and certifying that the provisions of Government Code section 7522.56 requiring a one-hundred eighty (180) day separation period for retired employees returning to employment as extra-help are not applicable to Mr. Ferdolage, because of the nature of Mr. Ferdolage's employment and his appointment is necessary to fill a critically-needed position before one-hundred eighty (180) days has passed following the date of Mr. Ferdolage's retirement.


