CRISIS RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT FACILITY (CRT) Sealed proposals will be received at the Fresno County Department of Public Works and Planning (Department), Office of the Design Engineer, Seventh Floor, Fresno County Plaza Building, 2220 Tulare Street, Fresno, CA 93721 until 2:00 P.M., (1400 hours and 00 seconds) Thursday, November 17, 2016, at which time the bidding will be closed. A pre-bid conference will be held at 3 p.m., on Wednesday, November 2, 2016. A discussion of the project will be held and the project site will be open for examination. Contractors should meet at Kings Canyon Campus, Parking Lot 'K', located west of South Barton Ave. and south of Huntington Blvd. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is not mandatory; however, the scheduled pre-bid will be the only opportunity for prospective bidders to visit the site in the presence of County staff and requests for individual site visits with County staff will not be granted. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. Pursuant to Labor Code section 1771.1, any Contractor bidding, or subcontractor to be listed on a bid proposal subject to Public Contract Code Section 4104, shall not be qualified to bid unless currently registered and qualified to perform public works pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5. No Contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract or perform work on any contract for public work without proof of current registration with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5 to perform public works. The work to

be done consists, of new construction of the Crisis Residential Treatment Facility, parking and associated site improvements. The project consists of a wood-framed, single-story building of approximately 11,700 square feet on a site of approximately 1.2 acres.
