WHEREAS, David Aguilar moved to Fresno as a young boy and joined the U.S. Army in March 1943 at the age of 20 after being called up by the draft. David married his wife Francis as a teenager and spent 60 years with her. The two had three daughters together; and

WHEREAS, David became Private First Class where he fought in multiple battles against German troops, in Central Europe, and has since been awarded – among others – the Good Conduct Medal, the Bronze Service Star, and the Combat Infantryman Badge; and


WHEREAS, family members describe David as friendly and giving, helping others and serving his community by visiting schools and talking to kids about his experience during World War II; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2015, David was awarded The Legion of Honor – France's highest honor – for his service and sacrifice during the Battle of the Bulge in World War II.


