# Road Improvement Program (RIP)

A planning and budgeting document:

- Required by the County's General Plan every 5 years or more often as needed.
- Guides your Board's road priorities
- Living document that adjusts over time
- Shows projections, revenues and costs
- SB-1 / Road Maintenance & Rehabilitation Account project list

# Project Selection

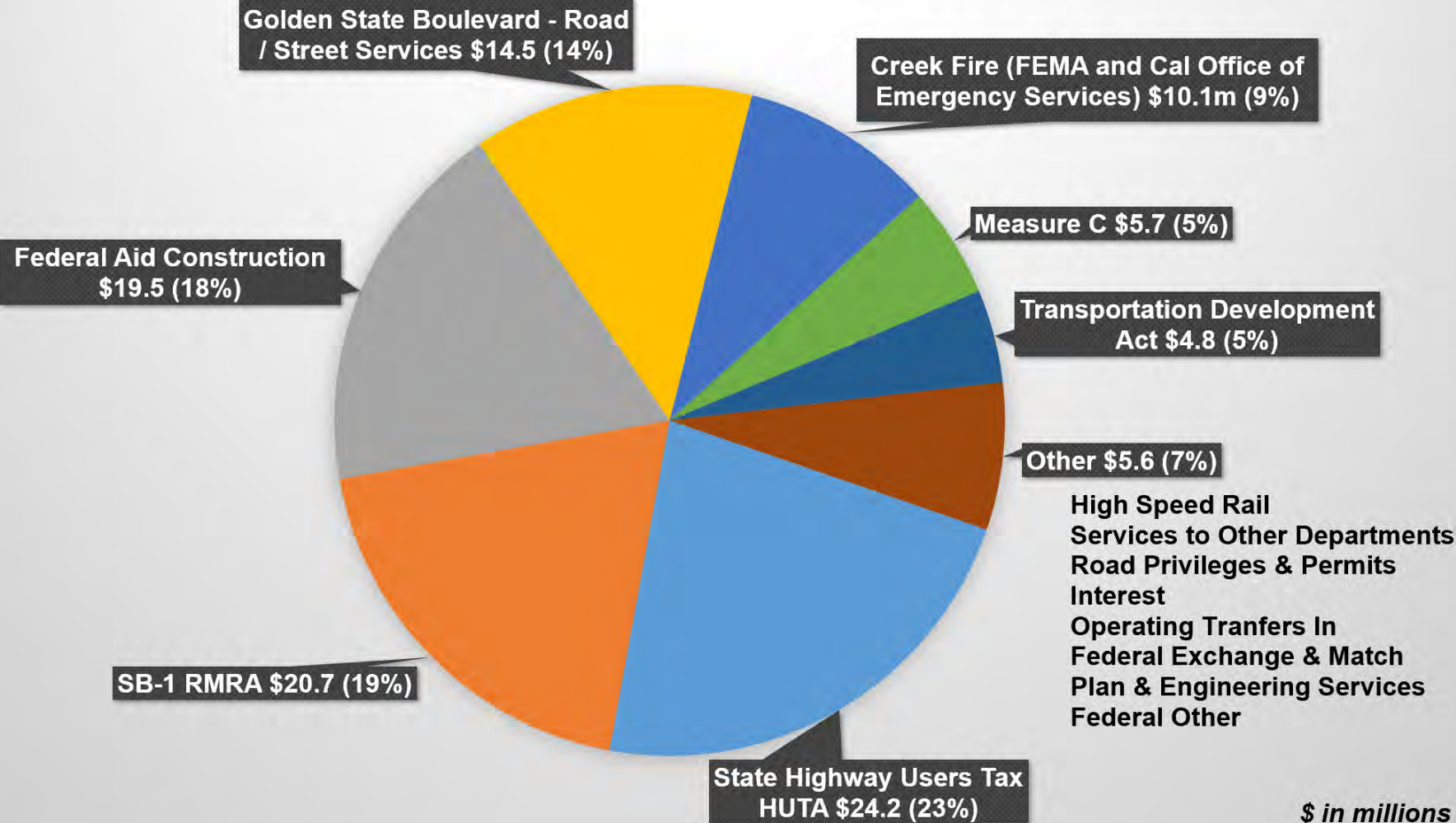
## Considerations:

- Needs – safety, road or bridge condition, traffic patterns and volume
- Funding availability – Federal and State fund availability and deadlines
- Direction given by the Board

**Project type selections** are governed by technical considerations and funding guidelines

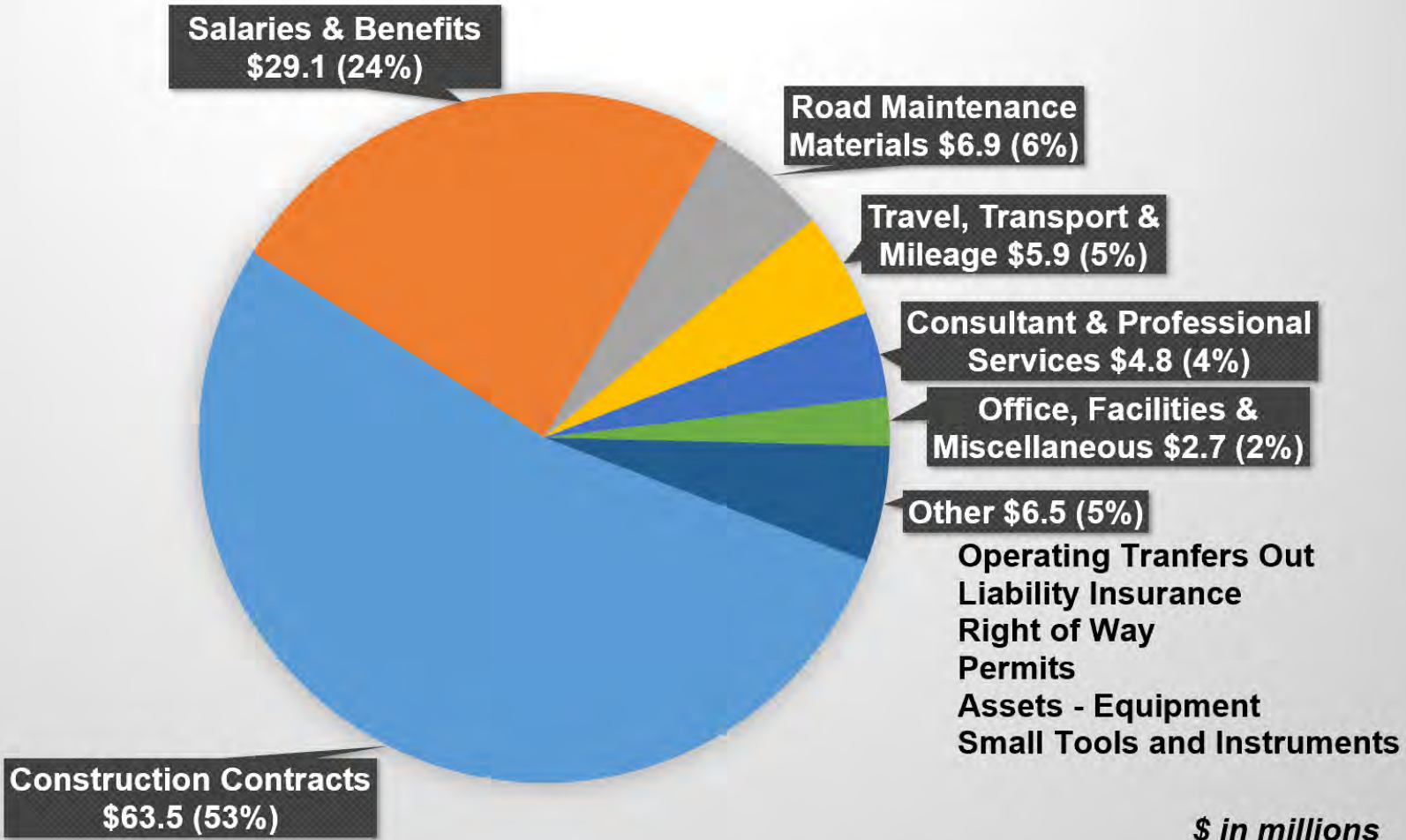
**Schedules** are determined by staff and consultant availability, priority (safety, usage, etc.), other agency review, right-of-way acquisition, utility relocation, and funding deadlines
