



# Timeline

- ▶ July 2018: Your Board approved a 3-year fee increase
- ▶ October 2021: Latest Board-approved fee increase took effect
- ▶ May 2023: DPH began reviewing MSF and Ordinance updates
- ▶ August 2024: DPH completed a fee study and time-task analysis
- ▶ November 2024: Fee calculation methodology approved by the ACTTC  
  
DPH sent notice to business owners and held 3 public hearings, 2 in English and 1 in Spanish, with 33 total public participants
